Overview

ACCELERATE works with the National AIDS Control Organisation, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare to implement, evaluate and transition sustainable and novel models of HIV testing and care guided by evidence-based practices to achieve HIV epidemic control in India. We began field operations in October 2019, in collaboration with State AIDS Control Societies (SACS).

ACCELERATE is led by the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine in Baltimore Maryland, U.S. and funded by the U.S. Agency For International Development (USAID). USAID administers the U.S. foreign assistance program providing economic and humanitarian assistance in more than 80 countries.

Index Testing

ACCELERATE is supporting individuals living with HIV to link their partners and family members to HIV testing services, both and facility and community settings. We provided index testing services to 2,820 individuals in third quarter (Apr-Jun 2021).



Reaching populations virtually

ACCELERATE is working to reach more people with HIV care through virtual services including remote counselling and commodity delivery. Yes4Me.net is our web platform for online outreach and communication, reaching to 7000+ online clients for HIV testing.



Integrated Healthcare

ACCELERATE is leading demonstration projects to pilot models for integrated HIV care. Our integrated health centres provide one-stop-shops for care, offering HIV testing, treatment and care combined with other services including mental health, sexual and reproductive health and non-communicable diseases. The first comprehensive transgender health clinic was launched in Hyderabad, Telangana in January 2021.



Supporting Children and Families of People Living with HIV (PLHIV)

ACCELERATE facilitates access to health and social services for children affected by or living with HIV. These services cover a variety of needs-based domains, including health, nutrition, education, vocational skills and parenting education. The project provided services to 26,780 children in the third quarter (Apr-Jun 2021).

Working with Communities

ACCELERATE is committed to communityoriented programming. Our cadre of peer navigators, who support people in their own communities overcome barriers to HIV care and treatment, offer a direct link to community perspectives. We consult community advisory boards and maintain feedback mechanisms with beneficiaries across the activities to design and adapt services to community needs.
